Call to Order

The August 01, 2022 regularly scheduled meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council was called to order by Council President, Scott Myers at 7:02 PM with all present standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer led by Mark Deeter. Boro. Maint.

- Water Report – The July water report was reviewed.
- Klingensmith’s parking lot retaining wall – Plain facing blocks have been received.
- Fairgrounds Water Tank – Currently waiting on test results. Tank will be returned to service once test results are favorable. Touch-up on the outside of the tank will be done this week.
- Frank reported maintenance remains very behind due to resources being at 1.75 staff, status pending on Jeff. The Mayor requested assistance to hang banners. There was also discussion of possibly using community service hours to assist Boro Maintenance. Personnel will meet to determine other possible means to provide help to Boro Maintenance.
