Call to Order

The Dec. 5, 2022 regularly scheduled meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council was called to order by Council President, Scott at 7:05 p.m. with all present standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer led by Mark.

Persons to Be Heard

Frank reviewed the previous month's water report. Lost water is up to 1,000,000 gallons. Billed usage was up as well due to leaks found.

The water tank behind the Borough has been drained and taken out of service.

One of the new two new Borough Maintenance employees has resigned and the other is working out well so far.

Chief Malnofsky reviewed the police report. The 3rd annual Brady Cup will be held 01/14/2023.

Approval of Minutes

The Nov. 21, 2022 minutes were read and approved by a motion from Mark, second by J. B., and a unanimous vote.

Financial

Bank Account balances were shown plainly on reports provided for Council review. Mark made a motion to pay the bills, that was seconded by J. B., and carried by unanimous vote.

Traditional Thanksgiving & Christmas gift cards for employees were approved by a motion from Roger, second from Pam, and a unanimous vote.

2023 Budget is advertised to adopt at the 12/19/2022 meeting due to Thanksgiving publishing schedule.

Upcoming Budget work sessions were scheduled for Tues., Dec. 13, 2022 and Thurs., Dec. 15, 2022 from 6:00 p.m. - 7:00 p.m. at the Borough Building. Inviting Municipal Authority members to attend.

Projects

The Engineer Report was provided for review. Due to election of a new governor, Multi-Modal grant decision is not expected until January 2023.

Committee Reports

Mayor: Tim reported that the Klingensmith's parking lot electric bill gets paid by the chamber of commerce which has recently dissolved. Roger confirmed and believes left over money was donated to the Lions. His understanding is that the bill has been paid current. This electric service is used for community events, powers vendor stands, etc. such as the Police Association Community Days. The mayor asked if the Borough would be willing to take responsibility for this bill. Roger made a motion that the borough take over this bill. J. B. seconded and the motion received a unanimous vote in favor.

Public Safety & Police: None

Personnel Committee: Employment letter was approved by Borough solicitor, and upon his recommendation, was sent to Selective insurance attorney for approval, advice. Selective attorney advised to suspend termination and extend insurance coverage until after Jan. 18, 2023 mediation hearing.

A resignation email was received from the Assistant Borough Secretary due to family health issues. General consensus was in favor of advertising the position for hire immediately.

Building Committee: Mark recommended hiring someone else to finish the repair of the roof between the Fire Hall and Community Building. Joe Switzer, who began the job, has not responded and has not come back to finish in several months.

Election crews from both municipalities request curtains or blinds on sunny window in Community Bldg. The building will research and give recommendations.

Streets Committee: Clarion County Liquid Fuels grant projects application was submitted 11/17/2022 by Marc/PennDOT rep. Decision is expected in December.
