Call to Order

The Feb. 02, 2026 regularly scheduled meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council was called to order by Council President, Scott at 6:59 p.m. with all present standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer led by Mark.

Persons to Be Heard

A. Borough Maintenance Supervisor Report, Dylan Shirey:

Council reviewed the water report. Medardo is still using a lot of water and are fixing another leak next Mon., 02/09/2026. Several frozen meters and valves. Sandie Ruffner's service across from Certasite froze between curb valve and main.

Authority is looking at getting new pumps at water pump station, are 35 years old.

Davis Hauling & Excavating is helping tomorrow with Community Bldg. snow removal. Borough Maintenance looking to reduce corner snow piles for sight lines.

Some present were aware of Frank using a variety of people involving Justin Davis, Eric C., John Rentler, Jay Stewart and possibly others for snow removal, though he managed this and his method not necessarily known outside of his office. General consensus in favor of rotating among local contractors for snow removal and leak repairs. Borough Office can share a list of those who have provided their contact information in recent years.

1. Inform Boro. Maint. to contact fire chief whenever there is a water leak or emergency so fire company can plan emergency water source(s) around leak location, etc.

Unfinished Business

Smaller, old firemen’s generator is currently powering 2-3 lights and radio in the station. Winter storm evaluation is that this generator could possibly keep folks warm and run a light or two in the Community Building in an emergency. Members expressed interest in getting a generator for outside that will do more and set it on a pad; get spot deeded from Fire Co. for it after they finish their new building. Justin Davis thought firemen would be cooperative, in favor of this idea. Firemen intend to start construction of their new building in spring.

Josh appeared to be taking this information down.

Motion to sponsor 250th anniversary celebration to coincide with Community Days Aug. 8-9th at minimum, Karina second, carried. Financial amounts to be discussed at a later date once more information is gathered.
