Call to Order

The Jan. 06, 2025 regularly scheduled meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council was called to order by Council President, Scott at 7:00 p.m. with all present standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer led by Mark.

Persons to Be Heard

Water Report, Borough Maint.: Frank McNaughton reviewed the water report for December. As reported in previous meeting, water meter to Rimersburg Borough from East Brady stopped 11/16/2024, estimated from that date for 17 days overlapping into the December period. Estimates are reasonable, based upon solid data. Has been repaired since and is now on actual readings.

Sensus meter reading import issue causes billing issue for 2 customer accts. Council unanimous general consensus in favor of charging minimum bill to these two customers this month as a one-time consideration and begin anew with January usage bill since meters have been changed at these locations. Removed problem meters will be re-calibrated to import to the correct decimal point by L/B water.

Officer Brown was not present due to active police call. December Police Report was provided for Council review.

The Municipal Authority meeting occurs after Council's meeting this month. Dan offered current status on the WWTP Upgrade Project since the design meeting.

Approval of Minutes

The 12/16/2024 council meeting minutes were approved by a motion from Mark, second by J. B., and unanimous vote.

Financial

Roger made a motion to pay the bills, seconded by J. B., and approved with a unanimous vote in favor of paying the bills as presented.

Projects

An Engineer Report is provided with these minutes. No further discussion on borough projects.

Committee Reports

Mayor: Noted too much gravel-like winter weather material on local state roads from PENNDOT. Another commented that salt seems to be doing a better job on Borough roads than other material on state roads.

Public Safety & Police: None

Personnel Committee: Regarding Boro. Maint. 4 and Boro. Maint. Supervisor positions, general consensus in favor of offering interview to DJS for Supervisor. Supervisor position to be advertised as well. No starting wage decided yet, depends upon experience. A couple of descriptions to be sent from Dan. Personnel also to decide what duties.

Building Committee: No work has started on the Community Building to date. Mark will find someone else.

Streets Committee: None

Unfinished Business

Rental Inspector: Dee Bell informed Council President he is unable to take Rental Inspector position. Is still involved in Senior Rentals after all and believes is a conflict of interest as such. Discussion, with no action yet by Council.

322 Chestnut: SCCRPD attorney stated in a letter that constable use for this purpose would not be appropriate. Mayor plans to ask Borough solicitor if he can carry out this task with Council's blessing.
