Call to Order

The June 06, 2022 regularly scheduled meeting of the Rimersburg Borough Council was called to order by Council President, Scott at 7:03 PM with all present standing for the Pledge of Allegiance and a prayer led by Mark.

The following items were reported: White & yellow traffic paint has been ordered, white is in, yellow is not yet available. The total cost for Boro line paint is expected to be \$2,230.50.

Police

Southern Clarion County Community Days is scheduled for 8/13 – 8/14/2022. There will be a parade and DJ with events downtown on Saturday from 11:00 a.m. – 10:00 p.m. A car cruise is scheduled for Sunday from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Roger made a **motion** to allow use of the streets, Pam 2nd the motion, approved by a unanimous vote.

Public Participation

Chad Shirey, co-owner of the playground and ball fields stated the owners absorb cost of electric for these areas as well as take care of the lawn maintenance. They do not wish to pay for trash clean-up. They would like help from the community to keep the playground and ball fields free of trash, possibly using Boy Scout and Girl Scout troops. Mr. Kimmel (Union HS) mentioned this could be a Community Service project for senior year. A dumpster is available on location for use next to the apartment building. General consensus among attendees was all ideas presented could be helpful. No one volunteered to coordinate this effort. Chad is willing to purchase paint and supplies if something needs done at the playground or ball fields and someone is willing to do it. Tim will contact County to determine if Community Service volunteers can be used for trash pickup.

Approval of Minutes

The May 2, 2022 minutes were read. Pam made a motion to approve, Mark 2nd, and it was approved by a unanimous vote.

Financial

J.B. made a motion to pay invoices as presented, Roger 2nd the **motion**, motion approved by a unanimous vote. Items related to the American Rescue Plan funds were tabled until the July meeting.

Committee Reports

Mayor: Mayor was told the 105 Mill St. camper was being moved three weeks ago, it has not been moved. Chief Bob is working on the issue.

Personnel Committee: There was discussion on the possible need for additional maintenance crew.

Building Committee: Roger Crick/Lions have volunteers to convert Community Building big room to LED lighting. They will clean and rewire the lights, install bulbs. An offer was made at this time for a donation of 20 bulbs which is half of what is needed. Council was pleased to accept the donation as was Roger on behalf of the Lions. Pam made a **motion** to accept the Lions' offer to convert the event room of the Community Building and install LED bulbs, Mark 2nd, and the motion carried.

Mark will speak with Joe Switzer to fix leak on the Community Building roof to fire hall.

Streets Committee: Once Tracy has completed EMS training next week for certification, Alicia will meet about projects to help J.B. with quotes.

Mark made a **motion** to move ahead with Frank's recommendation for Klingensmith's parking lot retaining wall (estimated cost \$3,000-\$5,000), Roger 2nd the motion, the motion was adopted.
